TOP CHOICE Harold Dieterle, who won the first season of the television show "Top Chef," has opened a restaurant. At **Perilla** (9 Jones St. at West 4th Street, 212-929-6868), the former Harrison sous chef is dishing up springtime specialties such as crispy pork belly with pea tendrils, trumpet mushrooms, and a *banyuls-vanilla gastrique* (\$12), broiled Atlantic eel with grilled ramps, jicama, and mole coloradito (\$11), and roasted duckling with mustard greens, corn pudding, and foie gras bordelaise (\$27).
